

# Plastic



**YES**

- All visibly clean products and containers made of hard or soft plastic.

**NO**

- Breathing masks
- Blood bags
- Gloves
- Styrofoam
- Bags that contain/ have contained medical residues, cytostatics, antibiotics or hormones
- Packages with the hazard symbols listed below\*
- Infusion sets
- Catheters and feeding tubes
- Packing tape
- Protective aprons
- Tubing
- Dirty and sticky packaging

## Hints and advice

The plastic shall be clean and dry. Remove any tape, lacing, metal or rubber parts. A few examples of plastics that are recyclable, but people are often unsure of, are bags from ground or powdered coffee, crisp bags, plastic bottles from nutritional supplement drinks with lids.
